TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF SURFACE DRESSING 2019 - WARWICKSHIRE NORTH

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing the roads as indicated in the schedule below, to vehicular traffic.

C81 Spon Lane	Grendon	A5	Surface change near service road	Grendon Road, Atherstone Road, Old Holly Lane, Holly Lane, Watling Street and vice versa
D373 Grove Lane	Wishaw	A446	County Boundary	Lichfield Road, Holly Lane, Ox Leys Road and vice versa

The closures are required to facilitate carriageway surface dressing works.

PLEASE NOTE: 10MPH Speed restrictions will be imposed for the safety of all road users and of the contractors working on the carriageway, whilst work for surface dressing is being carried out and for a short period thereafter – advance signage will be in place as appropriate.

The Order will commence on 15 April 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that all works will be completed on or before 30 September 2019. **Please Note: The date(s) of each closure will be indicated by advance signage that will be put in place as appropriate.**

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.
